COMPETITION REGULATIONS

CortoEuropa

1. Organization

Linea d'Ombra Festival is an international film and audiovisual festival conceived and promoted by the SalernoInFestival Association, supported by the Ministry of Cultural Heritage, the Campania Region and the Municipality of Salerno, and implemented with the contribution of public and/or private entities, associations, foundations and sponsors. The Festival adheres to AFIC (Association of Italian Film Festivals) and to CFCC (Coordination of the Campania Region Film Festivals).

2. Dates

The twenty-seventh edition will take place in Salerno from 22 to 29 October 2022.

3. Project

Linea d'Ombra Festival is an event that aims to raise awareness and to promote the best international cinematographic and audiovisual productions, to relate the different forms of youth creativity and to promote their knowledge among the public, to develop projects that have an effective educational impact and productivity, to encourage the realization of collective works of young artists coming from different experiences, finally to enhance the cultural potential of the Campania Region on a national and international level.

4. Competitive section: CortoEuropa

Short films in digital format with a **maximum duration of 20 minutes**, produced in Europe in the two-year period 2021/2022, are admitted to the competition. The number of works admitted to the section in competition will be defined by the artistic direction and may vary according to the needs of planning and project coherence.

5. How to enroll

a. The submission of the films should take place:

- through the online registration platform: www.filmfreeway.com
- by direct invitation from the festival

b. Registration requires a fee of **€ 3** to be paid at the same time as entering the platform.

c. The **deadline** for registration to the preselection is **1 September 2022** at 23:59 UTC +1

d. The registration of the work in the competition implies full acceptance of these regulations. For any controversy, the Italian text prevails. For anything not covered by this regulation, the

organization of the festival reserves the final decision.

e. Accepting these regulations Linea d'Ombra Festival is authorized to use the selected films for the competition in the Passaggi d'Europa category. The organization of the festival will ask the entitled to authorize the presentation of the work in competition in other activities directly organized or sponsored by the Festival itself, even outside the dates of the review.

6. Admission to the competition

The artistic direction will communicate the official registration in the competition of the pre-selection films by **10 September 2022**. Upon receipt of this communication, the following materials must be sent with absolute priority, via e-mail or via file transfer service, to **intmanager@lineadombrafestival.it** :

- projection file in .mp4 format (Codec h264) with a size not exceeding 2 GB;
- .srt file of subtitles in Italian, if available or .srt file in English;
- synopsis (.doc, .rtf or .pdf format);
- director's bio-filmography (.doc, .rtf or .pdf format);
- photos of the film and the director;
- technical sheet of the film (.doc, .rtf or .pdf format).

7. Hospitality

The management is pleased to invite the director or a representative of the artistic or technical cast of the selected film to attend the screening of the work and participate in meetings with the jury, offering hospitality (room and board) for the set days.

Travel expenses will be reimbursed, upon presentation of the supporting documents, within a maximum limit of 200 euros, to be agreed with the artistic directors and the hospitality manager.

8. Jury and Awards

The **Linea d'Ombra Festival award for the best shortfilm in the *CortoEuropa* section**, worth € 2000, will be awarded by the Jury of Experts. The Popular Jury (registered and present in the room) and the LdoSocial jury (registered online) will award the **Linea d'Ombra Festival Award Plate for best shortfilm in the *CortoEuropa* section**. The votes of the Popular Jury are worth three times those of the LdoSocial jury. The Artistic Direction, having consulted the Expert Jury, will be able to attribute special mentions to those films that have shown particular technical and creative qualities.

9a. Screenings and Program

The program of the festival and the screening schedule are decided by the artistic direction and by the heads of the various sections. The films are presented in their original language with Italian subtitles. The festival will publish a general catalog, in Italian and English, on the official website which will include all the works presented in competition and out of competition.

9b. Coronavirus Emergency

In the latter case all the authors, producers and distributors involved in the festival may/must authorize the online presentation of their works, indicating any territories to be excluded, without prejudice to the protection of property and copyright.

By participating in the competition, unconditional consent is given, pursuant to the Italian law d.lg 30 June 2003, n.196 on the protection of privacy and the GDPR - General Data Protection Regulation - EU regulation n. 2016/679, to the use of personal data for all initiatives related to the event. The participant declares to have the legal availability of the work, to authorize its public screening without claiming any compensation, freeing the organization and the rooms intended for screenings from any present and future liability.
